Lentz provided an overview of Local Plan requirements, purpose, and guidelines. A review of the organization's vision, principles, and strategic goals were articulated. Key themes and strategies of the plan include Good Jobs Principles, Career Pathways framework, Work-Based Learning, and coenrollment amongst workforce ecosystem partners.

Lentz went over highlights of the plan by section. Section 1 includes local analysis of the region encompassing current labor force trends and education skill levels, knowledge & skills needs to meet employer demand, balance of technical skills with foundational workplace skills, focus on growing and retaining workforce, assessment of industries and sectors, labor force and workforce demographics, and driven analysis and goals through evidence-based practices. Section 2 includes services, highlights, and opportunities for local strategies encompassing analysis of workforce development activities, strengths and areas of improvement for the organization, alignment with One-Stop partners, connection to WIOA Title III Wagner-Peyser services, youth workforce investment activities, coordination of education programs, recognition of the need for supportive services, continuous improvement efforts with program performance & service providers, accessibility to services, investment priorities, industry
